



Intern Project Assignment

DESCRIPTION:

Recent increases in fuel and oil prices worldwide have had a large impact on flight operation expenses. Department policies to increase operation efficiencies that conserve fuel and attain the best available cost at point of purchase help pilots, dispatch and management contribute to these cost-saving efforts. FuellerLinx is a fuel management tool that has been helping flight departments reduce their fuel expense.
